1. Types of motorcycles accepted

- Any trials motorcycle or modified trials motorcycle from 1900 to 1985 - A motorcycle is considered eligible for vintage trials when :
 - o It has 2 drum brakes;
 - o It has air cooling of the engine;
 - o It has 1 or 2 rear shock(s);
 - o It has a maximum 35mm diameter fork.

2. Technical legal compliance

- The motorcycle must be equipped with a headlight and a red light mounted on the machine; - Liability insurance;
- A registration certificate;
- A license plate must be affixed to the rear fender (sticker type plate accepted); - A noise of 95db.

3. Security

- Footrests must be foldable;
- Brake and clutch levers must have "balls" at their ends;
- An engine cut-off device is mandatory, preferably a magnetic system but a push button or a decompressor will be accepted;
- A foam of handlebar will be affixed on the tee of fork or on the bar of reinforcement of the handlebar;
- The front sprocket will be protected;
- The rear sprocket will be protected by a "shark tooth".

4. Environment

Compulsory environmental mat to fill the tank up and to do the mechanics.
